EXPECTATIONS

Because our channel is public, many people, including teachers, parents, district administrators, and community members view our channel. Therefore, it is imperative that you are Mendez scholars both on and off camera. This means that students with good behavior and grades, and who wear scholarly uniforms will be allowed on camera. There will also be an application process and auditions for certain roles. There may be times when you have to come to school earlier or stay a little later after school for special film shoots. By signing up for this elective, you are committing yourself to contribute as a leader, team player, scholar, and positive crew member of this YouTube channel.

CLASS BEHAVIOR
